<b>Program</b>	Department of Information Management (Information Management of Manufacturing)		
<b>Program Description</b>	This program is designed to cultivate professional talent in information management for the manufacturing industry. Based on educational objectives, core competencies, and industry development needs, the curriculum is structured into general subjects, professional courses, and corporate internships. The program is employment-oriented; in addition to required common and general education courses, it also integrates a variety of courses in information management and practical training. Students may choose professional electives according to their interests to enhance their employability and competitiveness.		
<b>Graduate Career Development</b>	Career paths include Information Management Engineer, Software Design Engineer, Web Programmer, Information Systems Maintenance Engineer, and Data Science Engineer.		
<b>Mandarin courses (online or on-campus courses)</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The Chinese Language curriculum includes four required courses, each with 2 credits and 2 hours per week, totaling 8 credits and 8 hours. These courses are offered sequentially from the first to the third semester, and include Chinese (I), Chinese Reading and Expression, Chinese (II), and Chinese (III). The course content will be adjusted according to students' proficiency levels, providing suitable Chinese language learning opportunities.</li> <li>The Chinese Language Center provides consultation hours with Chinese language instructors and offers tutoring services. In addition, local student partners are arranged to assist with both academic learning and daily life adaptation.</li> </ol>

<b>Internship</b>	<p>1. Off-campus internships are conducted from 3-grade to 4-grade, with approximately four internship days per week. The maximum internship hours are up to 27 hours per week.</p> <p>2. Internship allowance and benefits:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Allowance : The internship allowance is calculated based on the Basic Wage stipulated in the Labor Standards Act, calculated by hour. The minimum wage in 2025 is NTD 190 per hour. If calculated monthly, the minimum compensation for fulfilling the legal maximum of 40 working hours per week is NTD 28,590 per month.</li> <li>● Benefits: Amount of employee meal subsidy.</li> </ul> <p>3. Institution: Kertz High Tech Co., Ltd., Sercomm Corporation, Inpaq Technology Co., Ltd. Chunan Branch, Fiber Optic Communications Inc.</p>		
<b>Work-study During Semester</b>	<p>Students who wish to work in Taiwan (either on campus or off campus) are required to apply for and obtain a work permit before starting a job. With the exception of the winter and summer vacations, students' total working hours shall not exceed 20 hours per week.</p>		
<b>Employment Counseling</b>	<p>1. University employment-matching channels and career counseling seminars, such as explanations of the point-based evaluation system and related measures.</p> <p>2. Talent-retention mechanisms of internship organizations.</p>		
<b>Further Education After Graduation</b>	<p>1. Graduates of this program may, in accordance with relevant regulations, take the entrance examinations for master's programs in information and management-related fields at various universities. Examples include the Master's Program in Information Management, the Master's Program in Business Administration, and the Master's Program in Computer Science.</p> <p>2. Students may also apply for admission to graduate programs at the university's sister schools or other overseas institutions, such as Middlesex University in the United Kingdom.</p>		
<b>Scholarships and Financial Aids</b>	<p>1. The OCAC provides the following grants and subsidies:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● The first two years of tuition grant: each new student will be granted NTD\$20,000 per semester during the first two academic years.</li> <li>● Excellent Conduct and Academic Performance Scholarship: Available for those with excellent academic performance. Those who have obtained certificates and</li> </ul>		

- competition awards will be awarded NTD\$6,000 per person per academic year.
  - Medical Insurance for Overseas Compatriot Students (6 months): A total of NTD\$600 will be subsidized (before students enroll in National Health Insurance).
  - Healthcare: Every student is required to enroll in National Health Insurance and pay the insurance premiums. Students who have proof of economic hardship (or financial difficulty document) are subsidized 50% of the insurance premiums. (Current monthly subsidy is NTD\$413).
  - Work-study subsidy and economic hardship scholarship: NTD\$2,500 per month for students who are offered work-study opportunities.
  - Emergency Aid: Provided on a case-by-case basis.
2. Scholarship and subsidies provided by the University:
- First Semester English Proficiency Awards: Students achieving a TOEIC score of 550 or above (Listening  $\geq$  275, Reading  $\geq$  275) will receive NTD\$1,000; those achieving 785 or above (Listening  $\geq$  400, Reading  $\geq$  385) will receive NTD\$2,000. Students achieving an IELTS score of 4.0 or above will receive NTD\$1,000, while those achieving 5.5 or above will receive NTD\$2,000.

**I. Tuition and Miscellaneous Fees:**

1. The tuition and miscellaneous fees must be listed separately and may not be combined. The fee standards shall follow the “Regulations on Tuition and Miscellaneous Fee Collection for Junior Colleges and Institutions of Higher Education,” and are calculated based on the amounts approved by the government.
2. Other fees:
  - Overseas Compatriot Student Insurance: NTD\$600 in total for the first 6 months after enrollment. Starting from the 7th month, National Health Insurance is NTD \$826 per month; for economically disadvantaged students, the premium is NTD \$413 per month.
  - Books: approximately NTD\$3,000 per semester
  - Student group accident insurance: NTD\$449 per semester
  - Computer and internet usage fee: NTD\$950 per semester
3. Dormitory Fees:

	<p>During the semester: NTD\$9,300–20,000 per semester (electricity charges are calculated separately).  During summer and winter vacations: NTD\$2,400 per month for a double room; NTD\$4,000 per month for a single room.</p> <p><b>II. Personal Living Expenses:</b>  Approximately NTD\$6,000–NTD\$8,000 per month, depending on individual spending habits.</p> <p><b>III.
